
Laparoscopy, an invasive procedure, remains the only definitive way to diagnose endometriosis.<sup>1</sup>

# Your patients may be eligible for our study.

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## **Inclusion criteria:**

- Patient, or an authorized representative or guardian, is willing and able to provide written informed consent.
- Patient is a female aged 14 to 50 years old at the time of consent.
- Patient is planned to undergo laparotomy or laparoscopy secondary to chronic pelvic pain associated with suspected endometriosis.

## **Exclusion criteria include (but are not limited to):**

Patient has a history of surgically-diagnosed endometriosis.

## **Expectations for participating sites and/or patients:**

- Blood sample collection
- Endometriosis health profile questionnaire
- Completed case report forms in electronic system within 10 days of patient visit
- Pathological and/or operative reports post-surgery
- IRB Approval
